The civils scope varied across many items including:

- Routeworks
- Foundations
- Signage
- UTX's
- LOC & REB bases
- Hardstandings
- Walkways
- Access steps
- Handrail's & fencing
- Signal structures & foundations

- Retaining walls
- Cable installation & recoveries
- Bridge arch repairs
